

Bible - FAVORITE SCRIPTURE of Cindy Williams

Ecclesiastes

2:24 A man can do nothing better than to eat and drink and find satisfaction in his work. This too, I see, is from the hand of God, for without him, who can eat or find enjoyment? To the man who pleases him, God gives wisdom, knowledge and happiness, but to the sinner he gives the task of gathering and storing up wealth to hand it over to the one who pleases God.

3:22 So I say that there was nothing better for a man than to enjoy his work.

4:9 Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their work.

4:12 A cord of three strands is not quickly broken.

5:10 Whoever loves money never has money enough; whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with his income.

9:10 Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might.

10:10 If the ax is dull and the edge unsharpened, more strength is needed, but skill will bring success.

11:1 Cast your bread upon the waters, for after many days you will find it again.

11:4 Whoever watches the wind will not plant; whoever looks at the clouds will not reap.

11:6 Sow your seeds in the morning, and at evening let not your hands be idle, for you do not know which will succeed, whether this or that, or whether both will do equally well.

12:13 Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.

May he give you the desire of your heart and make all your plans succeed. We will shout for joy when you are victorious and will lift up our banners in the name of our God. May the Lord grant all your requests.

Psalms 23 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord.

Psalm 34:18 The Lord is close to the broken hearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

Psalm 91:11 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.

Psalm 107 Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.

Psalm 139:14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

Proverbs 3:5,6 Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Proverbs 3:13-18 Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding, for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold. She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her. Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor. Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace. She is a tree of life to those who embrace her; those who lay hold of her will be blessed.

Proverbs 4:7 Wisdom is supreme; therefore get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding. Esteem her, and she will exalt you; embrace her, and she will honor you. She will set a garland of grace on you head and present you with a crown of splendor.

Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life. Put away perversity from your mouth; keep corrupt talk far from your lips. Let your eyes look straight ahead, fix your gaze directly before you. Make level paths for your feet and take only ways that are firm. Do not swerve to the right or the left; keep your foot from evil.

Proverbs 6:6 Go to the Ant, you sluggard; consider its ways and be wise! It has no commander, no overseer or ruler, yet it stores its provisions in the summer and gathers its food at harvest. How long will you lie there you sluggard? When will you get up from your sleep? A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest and poverty will come upon you like a thief in the night.

Proverbs 9:8 Do not rebuke a mocker or he will hate you; rebuke a wise man and he will love you. Instruct a wise man and he will be wiser still; teach a righteous man and he will add to his learning.

Proverbs 10:4,5 Lazy hands make a man poor, but diligent hands bring wealth. He who gathers crops in the summer is a wise son, but he who sleeps during harvest is a disgraceful son.

Proverbs 10:9 The man of integrity walks securely, but he who takes crooked paths will be found out.

Proverbs 10:10 A chattering fool comes to ruins.

Proverbs 10:12 Hatred stirs up dissention, but love covers all wrongs.

Proverbs 10:16 The wages of the righteous bring them life, but the income of the wicked brings them punishment.

Proverbs 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise.

Proverbs 12:18 Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Proverbs 13:11 Dishonest money dwindles away, but he who gathers money little by little makes it grow.

Proverbs 13:20 He who walks with the wise grows wise, but a companion of fools suffers harm.

Proverbs 16:3 Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and your plans

will succeed.

Proverbs 16:24 Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

Proverbs 17:6 Children's children are a crown to the aged, and parents are the pride of their children.

Proverbs 17:9 He who covers over an offense promotes love, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends.

Proverbs 17:22 A cheerful heart is good medicine...

Proverbs 18:16 A gift opens the way for the giver and ushers him into the presence of the great.

Proverbs 20:13 Do not love sleep or you will grow poor; stay awake and you will have food to spare.

Proverbs 21:14 A gift given in secret soothes anger.

Proverbs 22:1 A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold.

Proverbs 22:9 A generous man will himself be blessed, for he shares his food with the poor.

Proverbs 22:13 The sluggard says, "There is a lion outside!"

Proverbs 22:29 Do you see a man skilled in his work? He will serve before kings.

Proverbs 23:4 Do not wear yourself out to get rich; have the wisdom to show restraint.

Proverbs 23:21 Do not join those who drink too much wine, or gorge themselves on meat, for drunkards and gluttons become poor, and drowsiness clothes them in rags.

Proverbs 24:10 If you falter in times of trouble, how small is your strength?

Proverbs 25:4 Remove the dross from the silver, and out comes the material for the silversmith.

Proverbs 25:17 Seldom set foot in your neighbors house – too much of you, and he will hate you.

Proverbs 27:17 As iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another.

Proverbs 31:10 Proverbs 31 Woman...

1 Chronicles 4:10 “Oh that you would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that your hand would be with me, and that you would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain.” And God granted his request.

Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.

Jeremiah 29:11 I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans to prosper you and not harm you, plans to give you a hope and a

future.

Matthew 5:44-46 But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you... If you love those who love you, what reward will you get?

Matthew 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Matthew 7:1 Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. **7:6** Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and then turn and tear you to pieces.

Matthew 7:16 By their fruit you will recognize them.

Matthew 7:24 Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on rock.

Mark 5:36 ... “Don’t be afraid; just believe.”

Mark 8:23 ... “Everything is possible for him who believes.”

Mark 11:24,25 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins.

Mark 12:30 Love the Lord your God with all you heart and with all you soul and with all you mind and with all you strength.... Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these.

Luke 8:16 No one lights a lamp and hides it in a jar or puts it under a bed. Instead, he puts it on a stand, so that those who come in can see the light.

Luke 10:2 The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.

Luke 12:34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Luke 12:48 ...From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.

John 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **1:14** The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 10:10 ... I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

John 10:14 I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and my sheep know me.

John 14 Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, trust also in me. **14:12** I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these. **14:18,19** I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. **14:23** If anyone loves me, they will obey my teachings. **14:25-27** All this I have spoken while still with you. But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. **John 15:9** As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. **15:11,12** I have told you this so that my joy may be complete. My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you.

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came

by Christ Jesus.

Romans 5:3 but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope.

Romans 8:18 I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.

Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Romans 10:9 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. **10:13** for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Romans 11:6 And if by grace, then it is no longer by works; if it were, grace would no longer be grace.

Romans 11:29 for God's gifts and his call are irrevocable.

Romans 12:2 Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Romans 12:6 We each have different gifts according to the grace given us.

Romans 12:11,12 Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Romans 14:19 Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification.

1 Corinthians 10:23 Everything is permissible – but not everything is beneficial.

Galatians 5:22 For the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

Galatians 6:9 Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

Ephesians 4:23,24 to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

Ephesians 4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

Ephesians 6:13-17 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Ephesians 6:19 Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel.

Philippians 2:14 Do everything without complaining or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which *you shine like stars in the universe*.

Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will

guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up.

2 Thessalonians 1:11 With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may count you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may fulfill every good purpose of yours and every act prompted by your faith.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.

Titus 2:3 Likewise, teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but to teach what is good. Then they can train the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.

Hebrews 12:11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

James 1:2-4 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God who gives generously go all without fining fault, and it will be given to him. But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

James 2:14 What good is it, my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds? **2:17** In the same way, faith by itself, if not accompanied by action, is dead.... **2:18** Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by what I do. You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that – and shudder. **2:24** You see that a person is justified by what he does and not by faith alone. **2:26** As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead.

James 3:9 With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in God’s likeness. Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be.

James 3:17,18 But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. Peacemakers who sow in peace raise a harvest of righteousness.

James 4:3 When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with the wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

James 4:6 God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

James 5:12 Above all, my brothers, do not swear – not by heaven or earth or by anything else. Let your “Yes” be yes, and your “No”, no, or you will be condemned.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness and into his wonderful light.

2 Peter 1:5 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to your goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive

in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelations 21:3,4 ... Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away. 3:6 ... I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End.

Revelations 22:21 The grace of the Lord Jesus be with God's people. Amen
